MATERIALS

NICE PACKAGE WALL QUILT FEATURING FESTIVE BY JO CLARK

1/8 yard of each: Cosy Snowmen, Holly, Fairy Lights, Peppermint Twist, Gingerbread People,

Mistletoe, and Snowflakes

1/4 yard Christmas Stockings

1/8 yard each from Cirrus Solids: Lagoon, Amber and Lava

1/2 yard Limestone for Background

1/4 yard Cirrus Solids Lagoon for Binding

1 yard Cosy Snowmen for Backing

Note: All possible care has been taken to assure the accuracy of this pattern. We are not responsible for printing errors or the manner in which individual work varies. Please read instructions carefully before starting the construction of this quilt. If desired, wash and iron your fabrics before starting to cut.

CUITING DIRECTIONS

Cutting dimensions include 1/4" seam allowances. Note directional fabric when cutting rectangles for packages.

from each Gingerbread People and Holly:

4- 3"w x 2"h rectangle

from each Mistletoe and Fairy Lights:

4-3" squares

from each Peppermint, Cosy Snowman, and Snowflakes:

4-3"w x 4"h

from Christmas Stocking:

4- 3"w x 61/4"h

from Amber:

6- 21/4" squares

4- 1½" x 3" rectangles

3- $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

2- 1½" x 4" rectangles

from Lava:

6-21/4" squares

3- $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

2- 1½" x 6¼" rectangles

4- 1½" x 2" rectangles

from Lagoon:

4- 21/4" squares

2- 1½" x 6½" rectangles

4- 1½" x 4" rectangles

from Limestone:

4- 1½" x 25¾" strips

2- 1½" x 22½" strips

4- 1½" x 6½" rectangles

 $16-\frac{7}{8}$ " squares

8- 21/4" x 4 rectangles

1- 1¾" x 6½" rectangles

16- 1¾" x 2¼" rectangles

ASSEMBLY DIRECTIONS

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

- 1. Mark a diagonal line from upper left corner to lower right corner on the wrong side of all Cirrus $2\frac{1}{4}$ " squares and Limestone $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. [fig 1]
- 2. To make the package bows, start with the limestone $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x 4" rectangle. Place a marked (Amber) $2\frac{1}{4}$ " square RST (right sides together), on left side of the rectangle with diagonal line going from upper left corner to lower right center. Sew on the line. Press seam toward the solid color, trim bottom 2 layers to $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. [fig 2]
- 3. Repeat Step 2 placing a $\frac{7}{8}$ " Limestone square in the lower left corner on top of the (Amber) triangle. Sew on the diagonal line, press seam down toward the corner, trim bottom 2 layers to $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. [fig 3].
- 4. Repeat Steps 2 & 3 to the right side of the above triangle to complete package bow. [fig 4]
- 5. Repeat Steps 2, 3, & 4 with remaining 2¼" x 4" rectangles. Make 8 total: 3 Amber, 3 Lava, and 2 Lagoon bows.

- 6. Sew 1¾" x 2¼" rectangles to each side of the bows made in Step 5.(8 Total) Set aside. [fig 5]
- 7. Three different size packages are all pieced using the same directions. Follow **QUILT DIAGRAM** for color placement of ribbon and package fabric size. Gingerbread People and Holly fabric: sew a 3w" x 2h" rectangle to each side of 1½" x 2" Lava rectangle. (Make 2 sets of each fabric). Sew a 1½" x 6½" rectangle to join the two sets of each pieced fabric. Sew Lava bow to the top of package. [fig 6]
- 8. Snowflakes, Cosy Snowmen, and Peppermint use $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4" ribbons to join rectangles. Christmas Stockings is joined with $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{4}$ " rectangle and Mistletoe and Fairy Lights are pieced with $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3" rectangles. Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for ribbon color placement.

ASSEMBLING THE QUILT

- 9. Following the QUILT DIAGRAM, arrange packages in vertical rows piecing a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Limestone strip in between packages of row 1 and 3. Piece a $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " between the Christmas Stocking and Peppermint packages in row 2.
- 10. Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM and sew $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $25\frac{3}{4}$ " strips in between vertical rows. Add $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $22\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to the top and bottom of wall hanging.
- 11. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired and bind.
