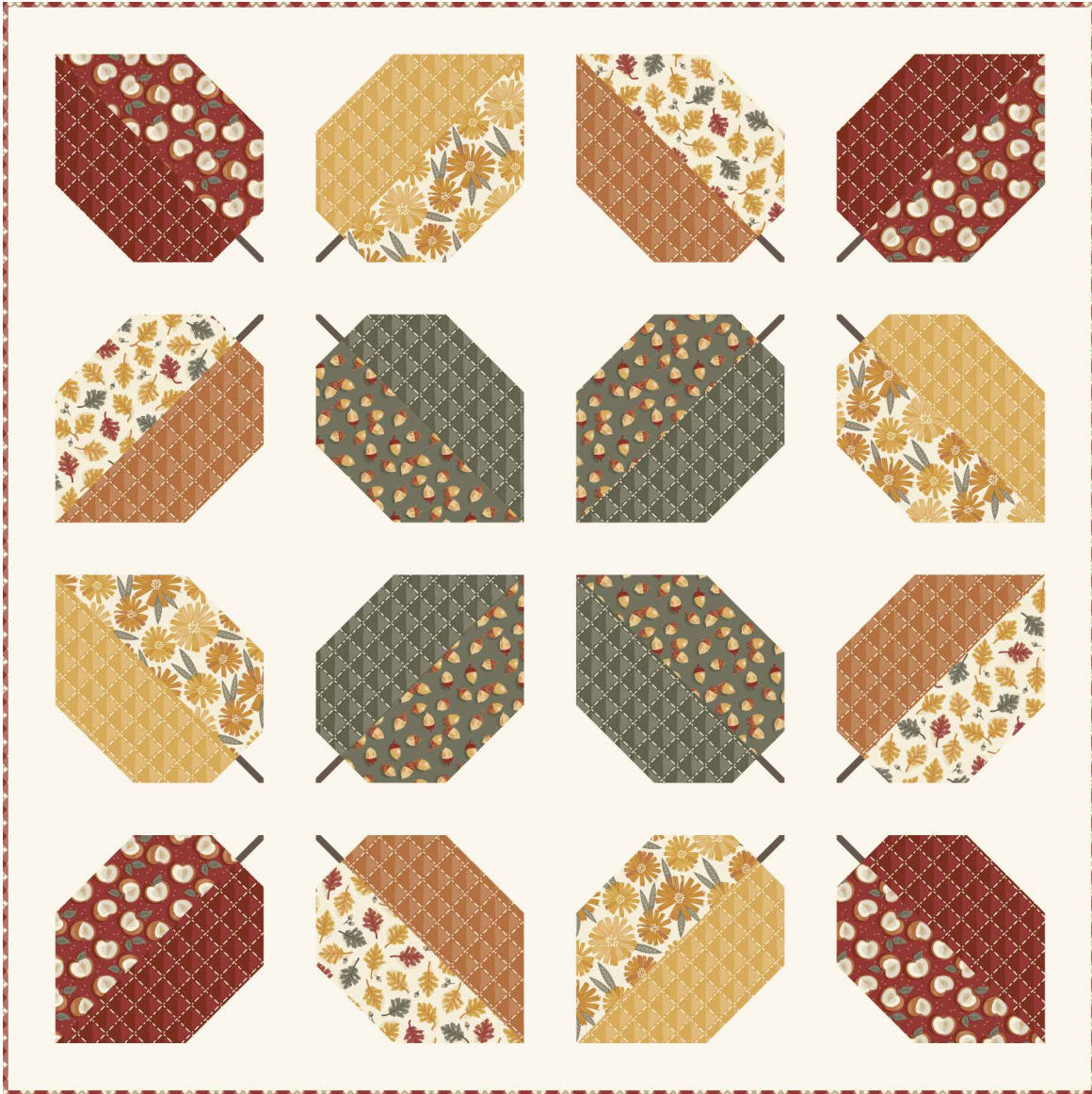



## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

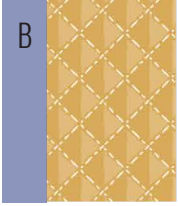
	YARDAGE
LEAF HALF (LARGE PRINT RECOMMENDED) 	1/2 yd ea
LEAF HALF (SMALL PRINT RECOMMENDED) 	1/2 yd ea
STEM ACCENT (OPTIONAL OR USE ABOVE PRINTS) 	1/8 yd or from leaf prints or from scrap
BACKGROUND 	2 1/4 yd
BINDING 	1/2 yd
BACKING 	3 3/4 yd

## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

*Cutting dimensions include ¼" seam allowances.*

### LEAVES A-H (FROM EACH):

(2) 13 ½" square

### STEM ACCENT (TOTAL):

(16) ¾" x 6" strips

### BACKGROUND:

#### FOR LEAVES:

(32) 4½" squares

(16) 4" squares

### BACKGROUND CONT:

#### FOR SASHINGS:

##### LEAF BLOCK SASHING

(1) 12½" x WOF

*subcut* into (12) 2½" x 12½"

(11) 2½" x WOF strips

**Join** end to end and *subcut*

##### HORIZONTAL SASHING

(5) 54½" x 2½"

##### SIDE SASHING

(2) 58½" x 2½"

## FULL ASSEMBLY DIRECTIONS

### BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. **LEAF UNIT:** Place two 13½" **LEAF PRINTS** (combined A+E, B+F, C+G, D+H) squares, right sides together. Draw a diagonal line and sew ¼" along each side of the line. Cut along center line and press to make half square triangle blocks. Trim to 12½" square (*fig 1*).

2. **STEM UNIT:** Cut each 4" squares from **BACKGROUND FABRIC** in half on the diagonal [fig 2]. Sew each ¾" x 6" **STEM ACCENT** strip to one triangle. Press to the stem. Sew the second triangle to the stem. Press, square up and trim to 3½" (*fig 2*).

3. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 4 1/2" squares. Pin square to each corner of a **LEAF UNIT** that does not have a seam. Sew on the line (*fig 3*).

4. Pin the 3½" **STEM UNIT** to one corner with a seam. Sew diagonally, trim the corner and press flat (*fig 3*).

### QUILT ASSEMBLY

5. Arrange **LEAF BLOCKS** according to **QUILT LAYOUT DIAGRAM**. Sew 2½" x 12½" **LEAF BLOCK SASHING** strips between **LEAF BLOCKS** to make rows.

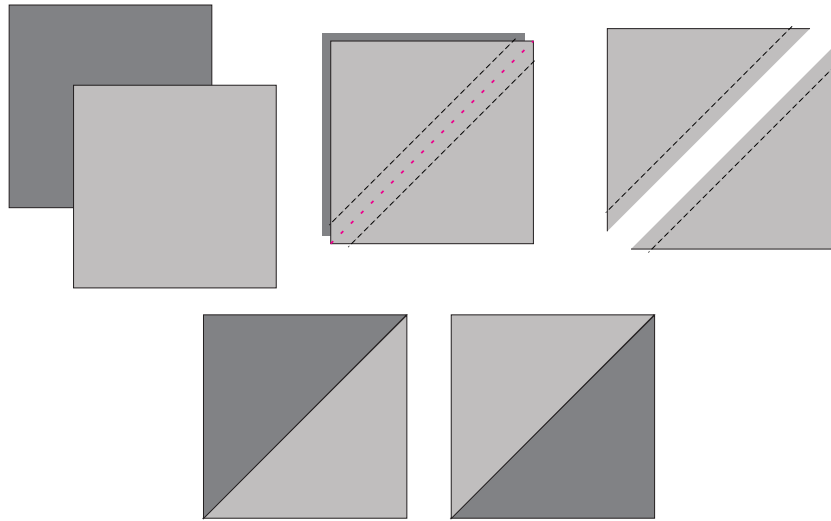
6. Sew 54½" x 2½" **HORIZONTAL SASHING** between rows to complete quilt top.

7. Sew 58½" x 2½" **SIDE SASHING** strip to the left and right sides of quilt top.

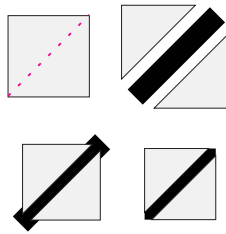
8. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Baste, quilt and bind.

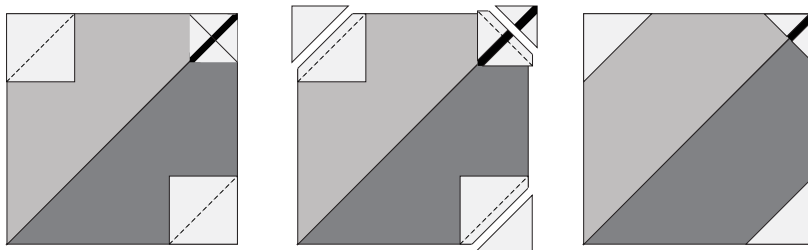
