1 ½ yards background fabric

1 Goodnight Moon 8½" squares panel

1 ½ yards Goodnight Moon 5" squares print

½ yard Goodnight Moon 2½" squares print

⅛ yard accent fabric

½ yard binding

3½ yards backing

SUPPLIES & NOTES

Rotary cutter & mat

Tape measure & ruler

Sewing machine & coordinating thread

Straight pins

Wash, dry and press fabrics before beginning.

¼" seam allowance unless otherwise noted.

HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE BLOCK

Press seams as you go.

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

FROM BACKGROUND FABRIC: (36) 4½" squares, (36) 5" squares

FROM 8½" SQUARES PANEL: (8) 8½" squares

FROM 5" SQUARES FABRIC: (4) 5" squares each from nine different prints (36 total squares)

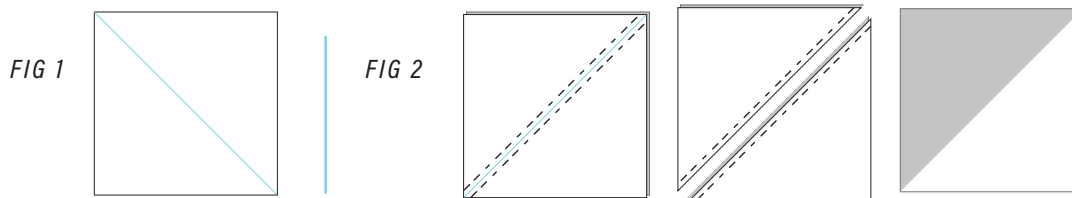
FROM 2½" SQUARES FABRIC: (104) 2½" squares

FROM ACCENT FABRIC: (2) 2½" X 4½" strips, (2) 2½" X 8½" strips

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

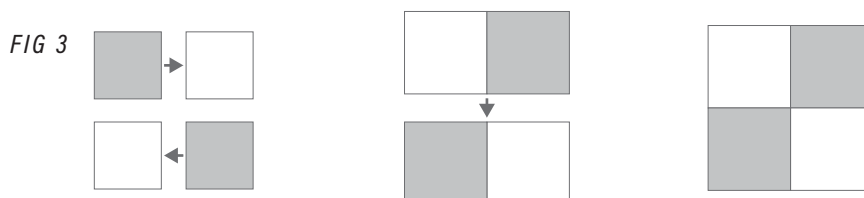
MAKE HST UNITS

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of all 5" background squares. [fig. 1]
2. To make HST: select a 5" print fabric square. Lay right sides together and sew ¼" on each side of the diagonal line. [fig. 2]
3. Cut on the diagonal line, unfold each and press seams toward darker fabric.
4. Square up block to 4½" square. Use diagonal 45° line on the ruler to help center blocks. Make a total of (72) 4½" blocks.

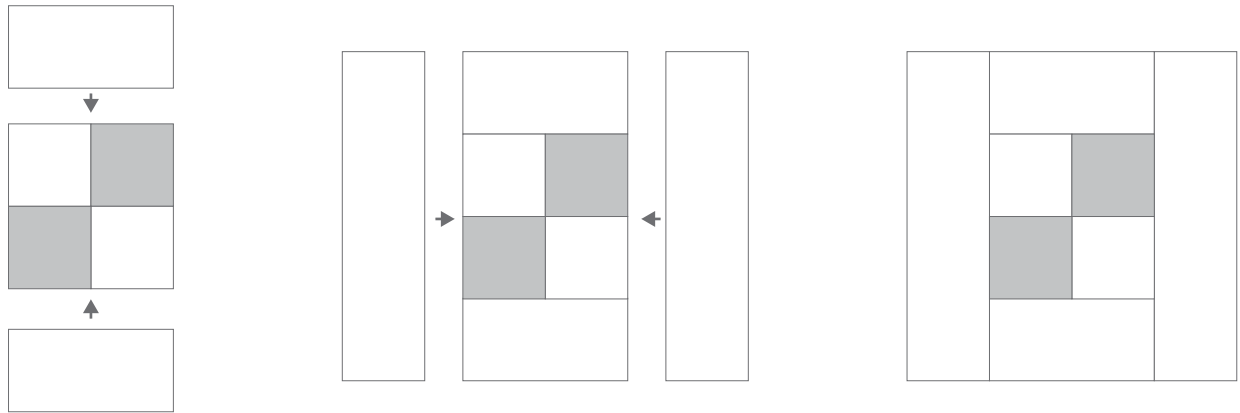


MAKE CENTER BLOCK

5. Sew (4) 2½" squares into a four-patch. Press seams open. Make (1) four-patch. [fig. 3]



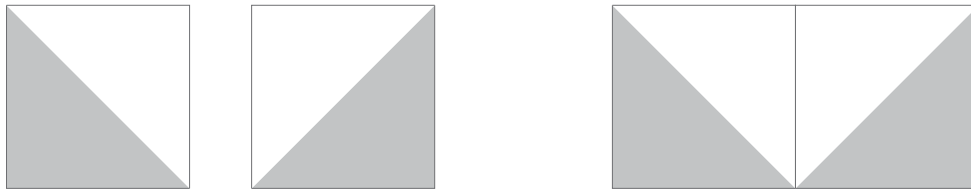
6. Sew 2½" X 4½" accent strips to top and bottom of four-patch. Press toward strips.
7. Sew 2½" X 8½" accent strips to sides of four-patch. Press toward strips. [fig. 4]



FINISH BLOCKS

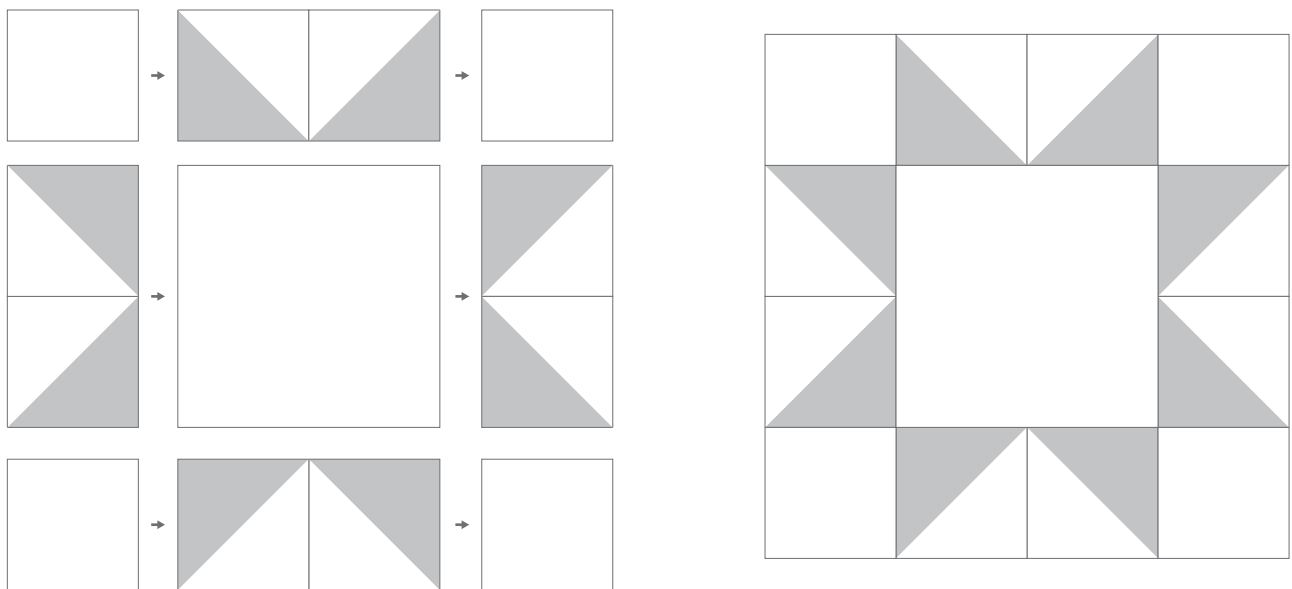
8. Sew HST units together to make flying geese. Press seams open. [fig. 5]

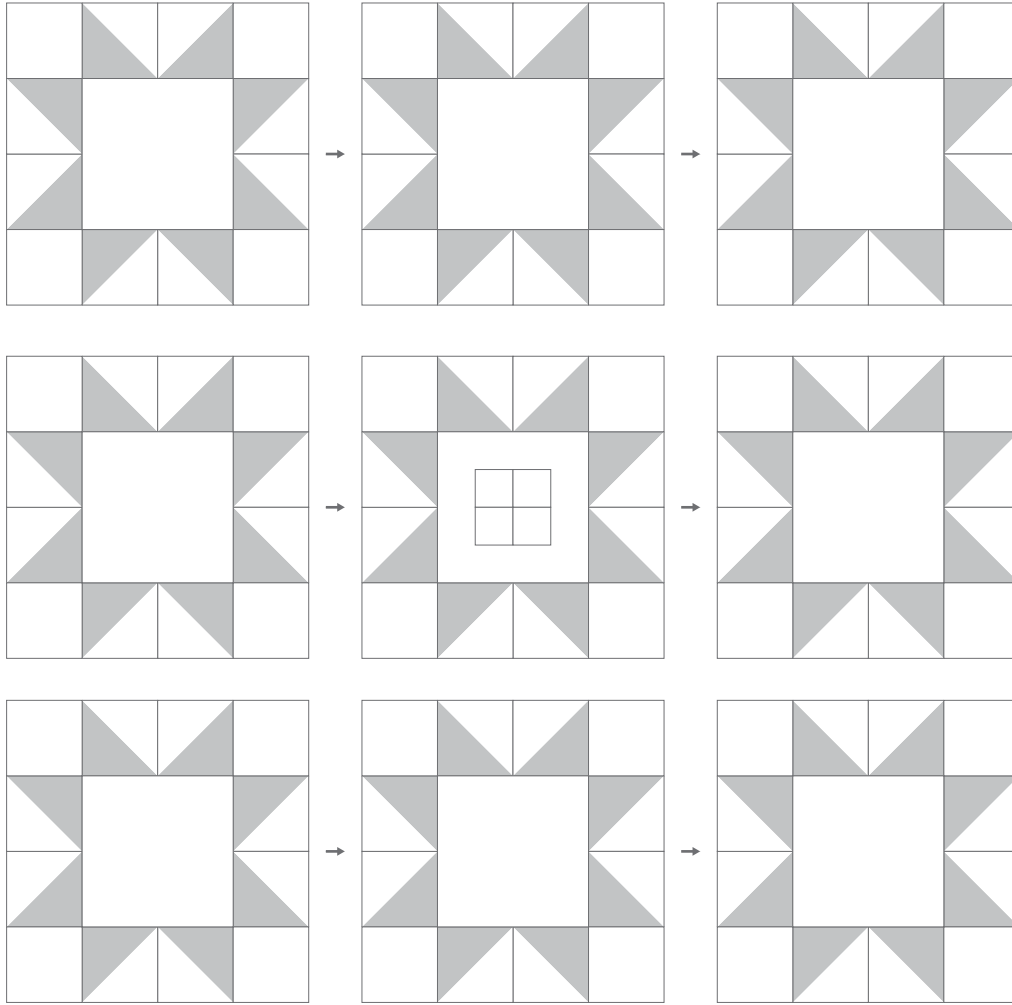


9. Sew units together into rows as shown. Press seams open.
10. Sew rows together into blocks. Press. [fig. 6]. Make (8) blocks with panel squares and (1) block with center blocks from steps 5-7.

11. Sew finished blocks together into rows. Press seams open.
12. Sew rows together. Press seams open.



MAKE BORDER

13. Sew $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares together into (2) strips of 24 and (2) strips of 26. Press to one side.
14. Sew strips of 24 squares to top and bottom of quilt. Press toward strips.
15. Sew strips of 26 squares to sides of quilt. Press toward strips.

FINISH QUILT

16. Layer the backing, batting, and quilt top.
17. Baste, quilt, and bind.
