FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

	PRECUTS	YARDAGE
10" X 10" FLORIOGRAPHY 	Minimum 13 10"x10"	–
BACKGROUND BG	–	2 1/2 yd
TREE TRUNK TT	–	1/4 yd
BINDING YOUR CHOICE	–	1/2 yd
BACKING YOUR CHOICE	–	3 3/4 yd

COVER QUILT FABRICS



Note: This pattern is meant to be assembled in a randomized way to your own preference. If you would like to match the arrangement of the cover image please refer to this layout for placement.



CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Cutting dimensions include 1/4" seam allowances.

10" SQUARES:

Cut (25) 10" x 5" rectangles for template A

TREE TRUNKS FABRIC:

(25) 1 1/2" X 2" rectangles for trunks

BACKGROUND FABRIC:

(6) 6 1/2" squares

(2) 12 1/2" X WOF strips

Subcut (25) 12 1/2" X 2" strips

(2) 10 1/2" X WOF strips

Subcut (25) template B

Subcut (25) template B *reversed*

(4) 4 1/2" X WOF for border

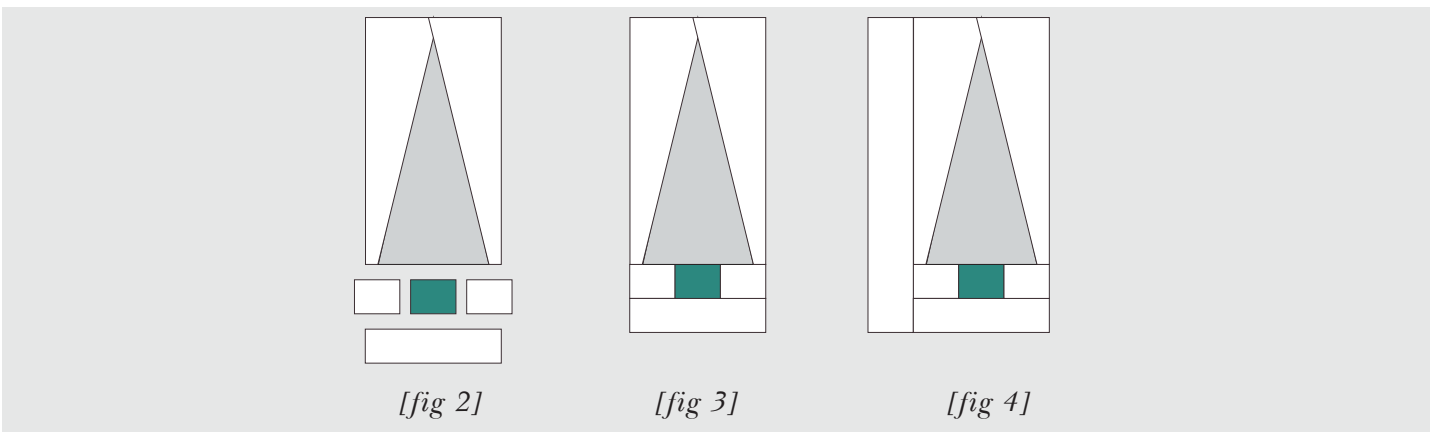
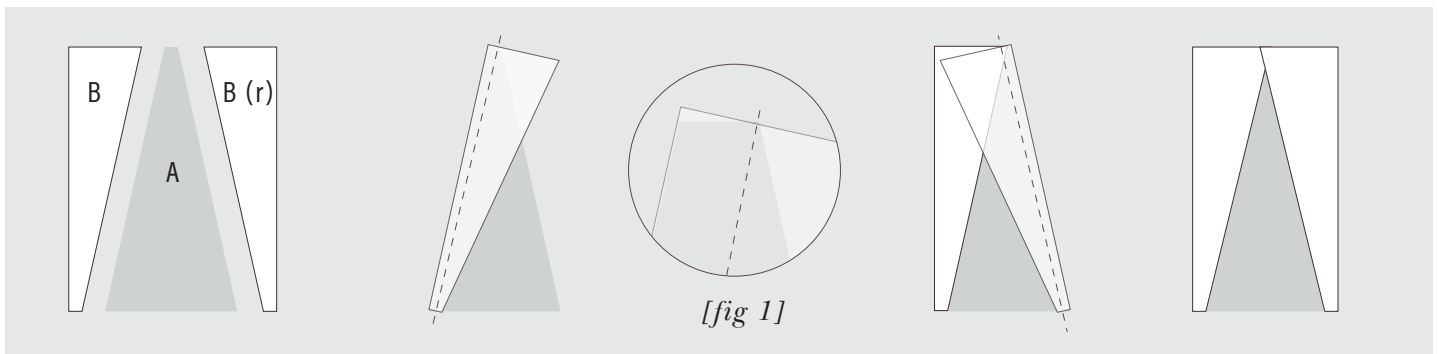
(2) 3" x WOF for border

(5) 2" x WOF

Subcut (25) 2" x 5"

Subcut (50) 2" x 1 1/2"

DIAGRAMS



TREE ASSEMBLY

1. Assemble blocks as shown. Template B pieces should extend beyond top of template A pieces by $\frac{1}{4}$ " [fig 1].
2. Sew a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" background rectangle to each side of a tree trunk rectangle [fig 2].
3. Sew 2" x 5" background strip to the base made in step 2.
4. Sew base to tree. Tree should measure 5" x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " [fig 3]
5. Add a 2" x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " background strip to the left side of all trees [fig 4].

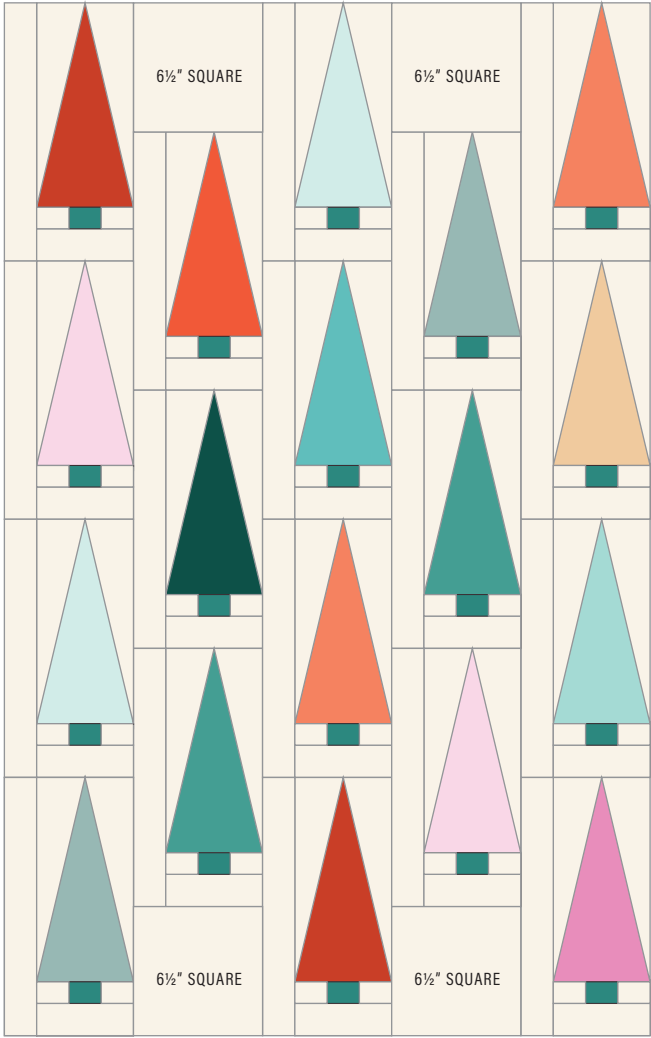
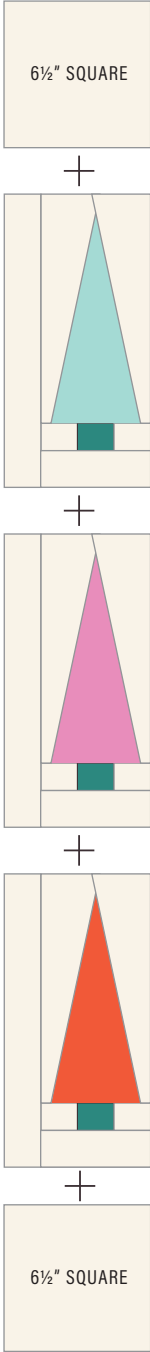
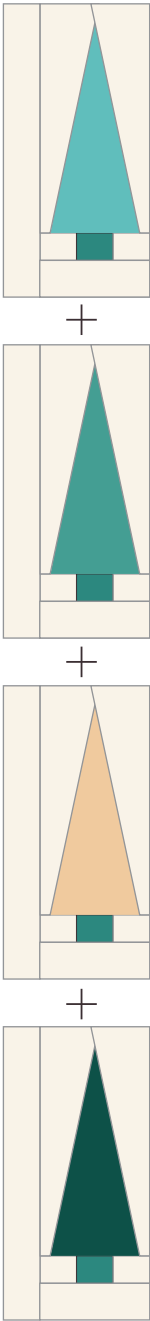
TREE BLOCK ASSEMBLY

6. Referring to the quilt layout diagram for placement and sew 4 trees end-to-end in vertical rows. Make 4 rows.
7. Sew 3 trees end-to-end adding a $6\frac{1}{2}$ " background square to the top and bottom of each of the 3 vertical rows.
8. Following the QUILT LAYOUT DIAGRAM, sew the 7 vertical rows. press in one direction.
9. Sew a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ " border to the top and bottom of the quilt.
10. Sew a 3" strip end-to-end to equal approximately $56\frac{1}{2}$ " and sew to the left side of the quilt.
11. Sew $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips end-to-end to equal approximately $56\frac{1}{2}$ " and sew to the right side of the quilt.
12. Baste, quilt, and bind as desired.

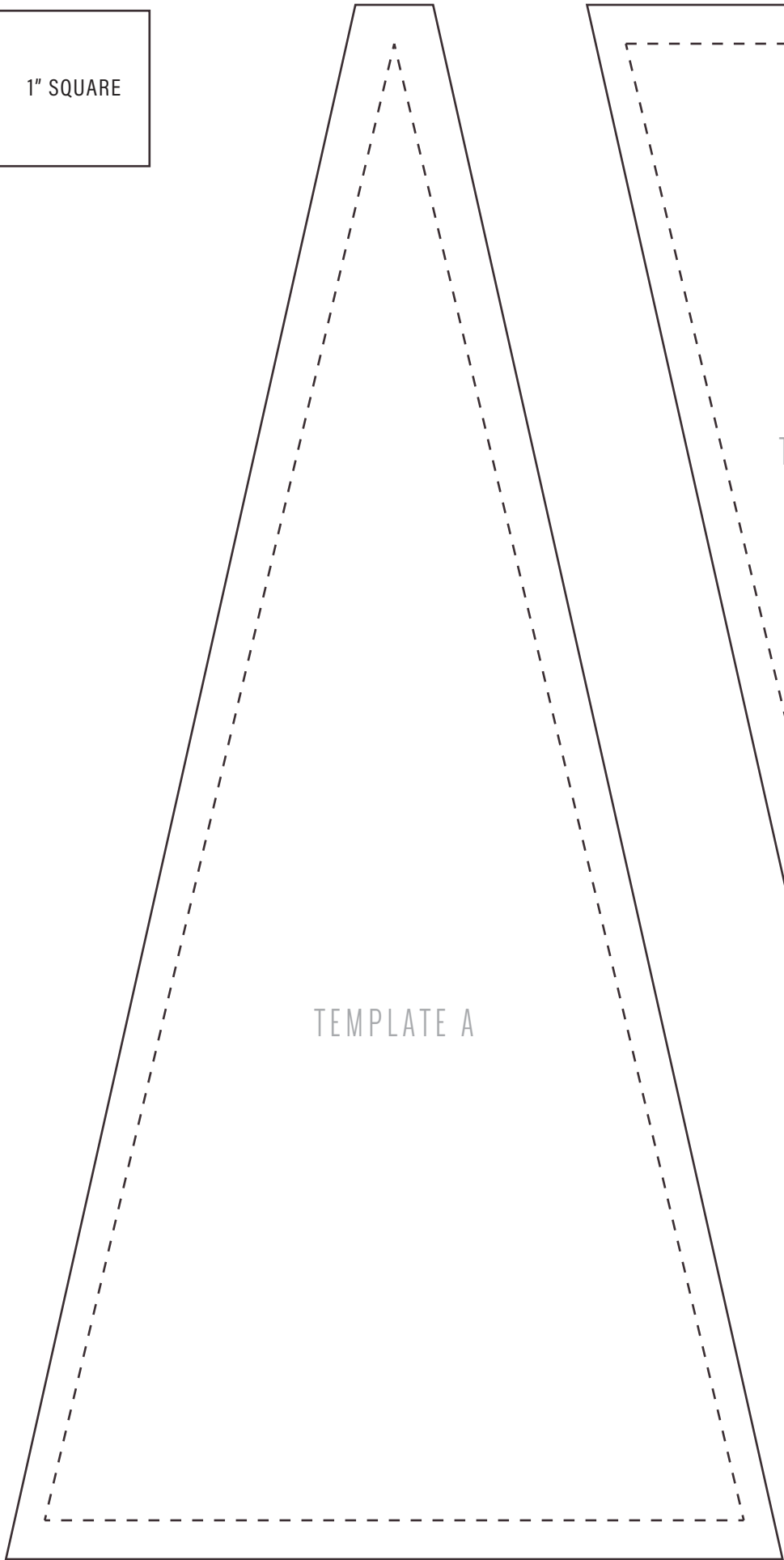

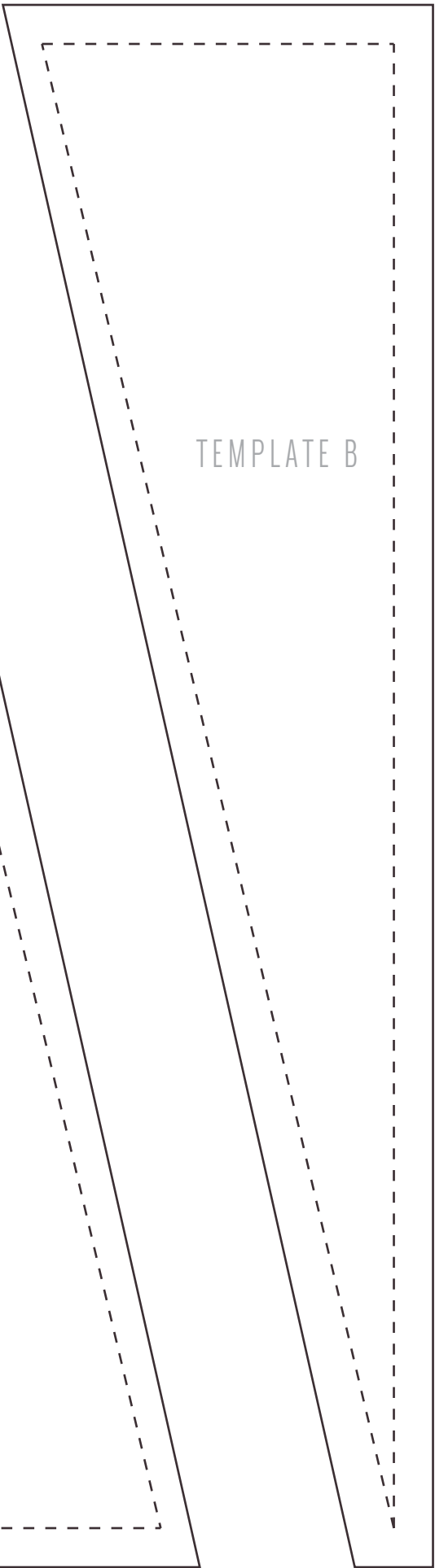
