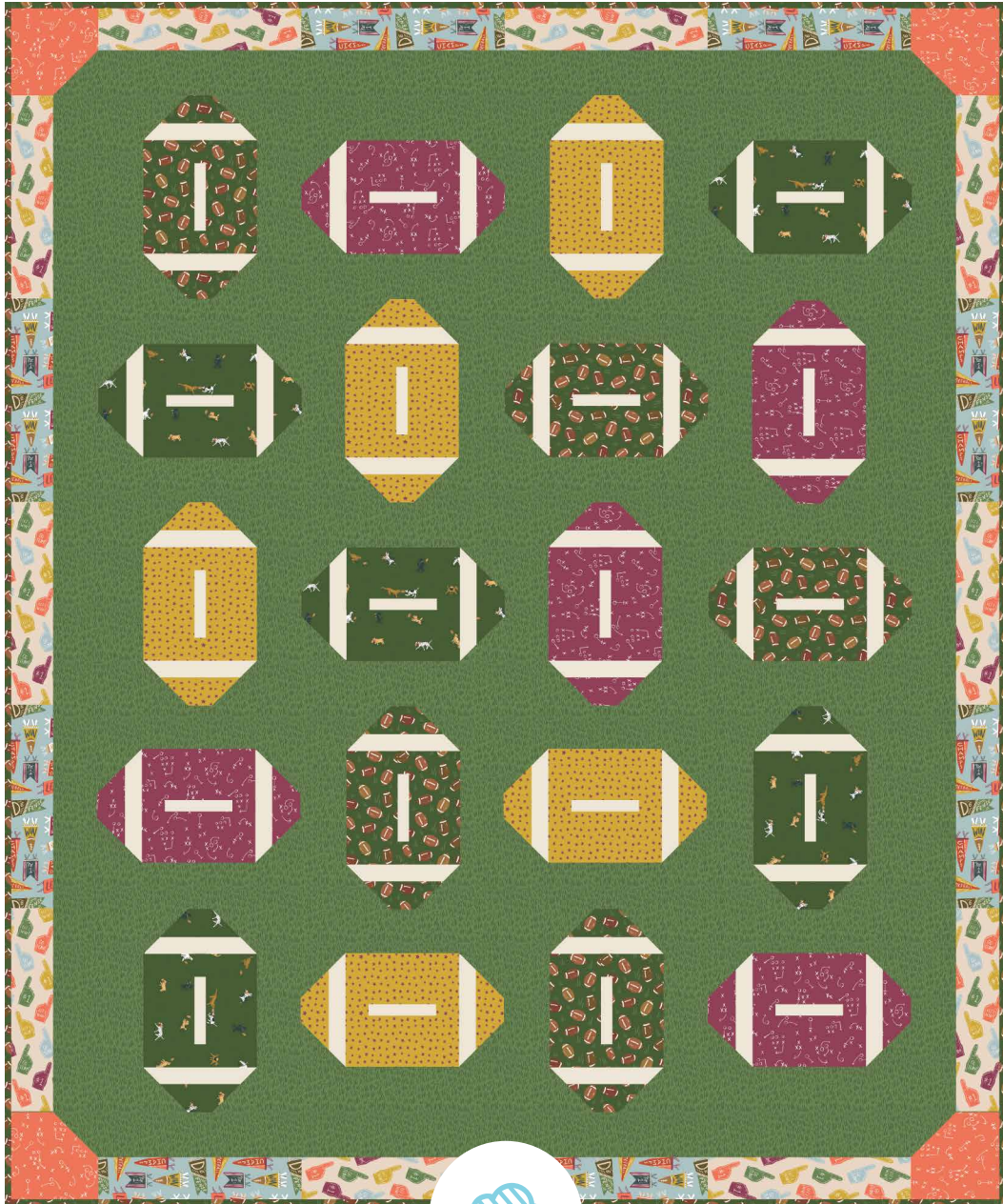

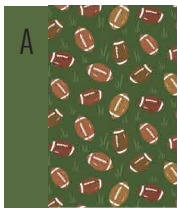

Please read instructions carefully before starting the construction of this quilt. If desired, wash and iron your fabrics before starting to cut.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

	YARDAGE
FOOTBALLS 	1/3 yd ea
BORDERS 	1/4 yd ea
CORNERS 	1/3 yd
WHITE ACCENTS 	1/2 yd
BACKGROUND 	1 1/2 yd
BINDING 	1/2 yd
BACKING 	3 1/2 yd

COVER QUILT FABRICS

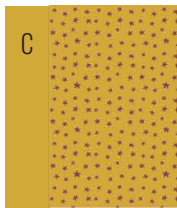
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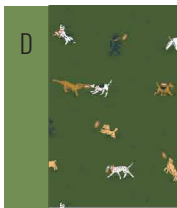
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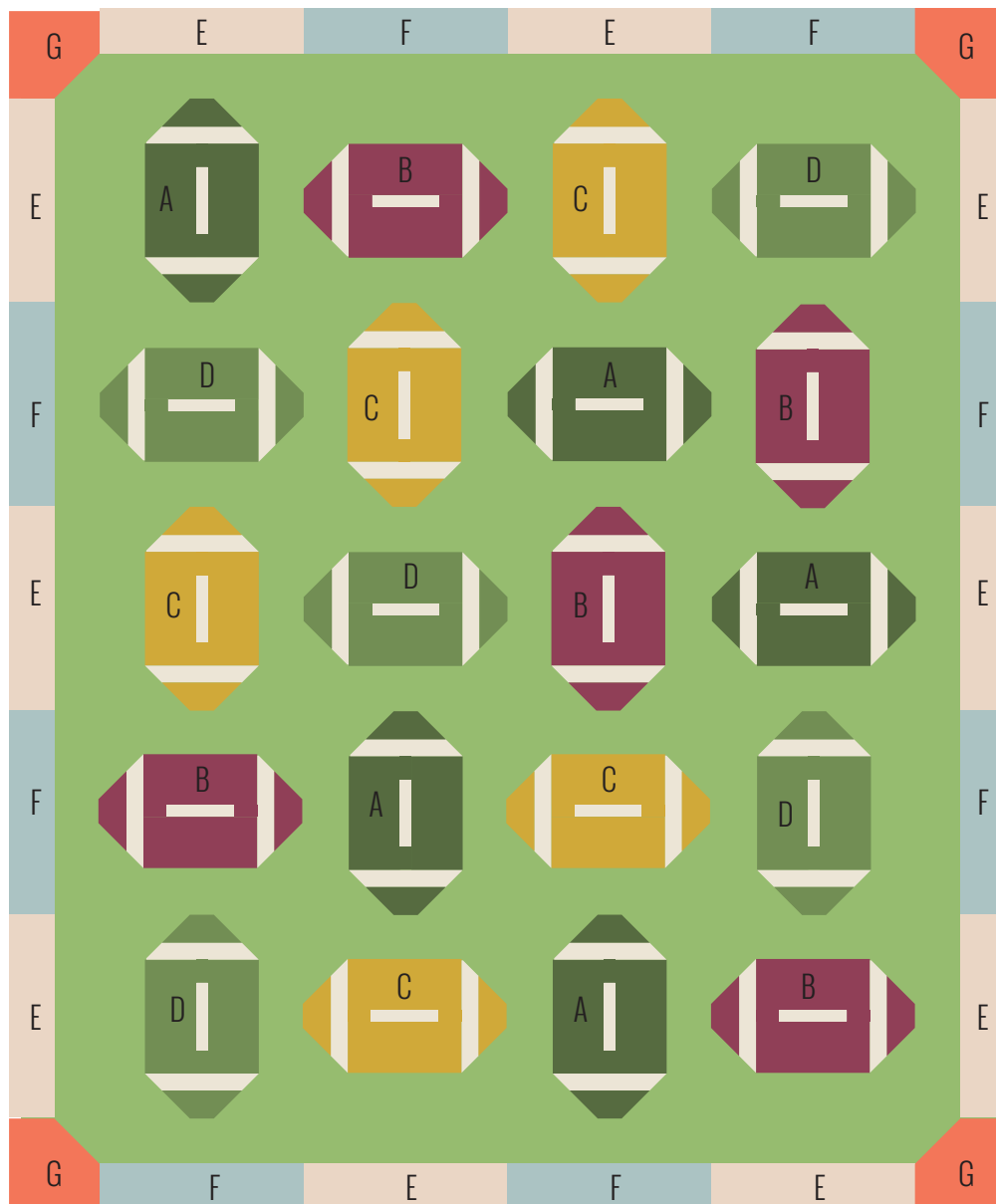
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CUTTING DIRECTIONS

FABRICS A-D (FROM EACH) : Cut

(10) 1¾" x 5½" strips

(10) 2¾" x 5½" strips

(10) 1 x 1½" strips

FABRIC E: Cut (10) 2½" x 9½" strips

FABRIC F: Cut (8) 2½" x 9½" strips

FABRIC G: Cut

(8) 2½" squares

(4) 2½" x 4½" strips

WHITE ACCENT: Cut

(40) 5½" x 1½" strips

(20) 1" x 3½" strips

BACKGROUND: Cut

(80) 2" squares

(40) 2½" x 9½" strips

(5) 2½" strips for BORDER 1

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

STARTING WITH FABRIC A

1. Sew each matching print of 1" x 1½" strips to both ends a WHITE ACCENT 1½" x 3½" strip. Press toward print strips *[fig 1]*.
2. Sew a matching 2¾" x 5½" strip to each side of strip from Step 1. Press toward larger strips *[fig 2]*.
3. Sew WHITE ACCENT 1½" x 5½" strips to end of Step 2 units. Press toward white strips *[fig 3]*.
4. Sew matching print 1¾" x 5½" strips to both ends of each Step 3 unit. Press toward print strips *[fig 4]*.
5. On the back of 2" BACKGROUND squares, draw a diagonal line. Line up one square on the corner of each Step 4 unit. Sew on the drawn line. Trim ¼" seam allowance. Press toward background squares *[fig 5]*.
6. Repeat on all four corners *[fig 6]*.
7. Sew matching BACKGROUND 2½" x 9½" strips to top and bottom of each step six unit. Press toward print strips *[fig 7]*.
8. Repeat with all FABRICS A-D to make 20 football blocks.

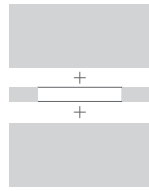

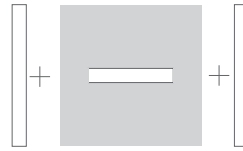

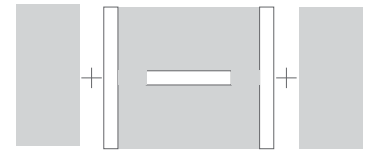

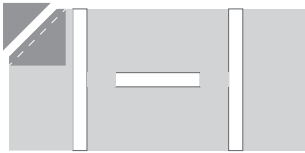

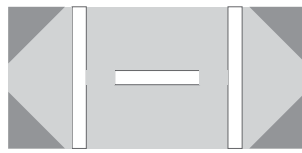

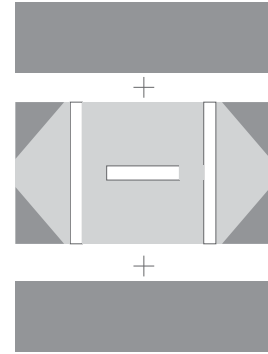

BORDER 1 TOP & BOTTOM - 40½"

9. Sew blocks together in rows, alternating rotation of footballs. Refer to chart for placement.
10. Sew rows together.
11. Sew 2½" BACKGROUND strips together end-to-end. Press open. Cut into (2) 45½" strips to make BORDER 1 (SIDE) and (2) 40½" strips to make BORDER 1 (TOP & BOTTOM).
12. Sew BORDER 1 (SIDE) strips to sides of quilt. Press toward strips.
13. BORDER 1 (TOP & BOTTOM): On the back of FABRIC G 2½" squares, draw a diagonal line. Line up one square on each end of 2½" x 40½" strip. Sew on the drawn line. Trim ¼" seam allowance. Press toward BACKGROUND strips *[fig 8]*.
14. Sew BORDER 1 (TOP & BOTTOM) strips to top and bottom of quilt. Press toward strips.
15. BORDER 2 (SIDES): Sew FABRIC E + F 9½" strips into (2) sets of 5, alternating colors. Sew a FABRIC G 2½" square to both ends *[fig 9]*.
16. BORDER 2 (TOP & BOTTOM): sew 9½" strips into (2) sets of 4, alternating colors. Sew a FABRIC G 2½" square to both ends of each and (1) FABRIC G 2½" x 4½" strip to the end of each 44½" strip *[fig 10]*.
16. Sew BORDER 2 (SIDES) 49½" strips to each side of quilt. Press toward strips.
17. Sew BORDER 2 (TOP & BOTTOM) 44½" strips to top and bottom of quilt. Press toward strips.
18. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Baste, quilt and bind.
